- **No prophecy, nor visions, nor “words from the Lord”** will be offered directly to the individual being prayed for. If a team member receives a special insight, they must clear it first with the Healing Room Overseer or the Pastor who will discern if such information should be given to the individual on that day or sometime in the future.
- **If the person being prayed for is not familiar with** and does not understand what **praying in tongues** is, avoid praying in tongues.
- **Anointing with oil** will be standard practice unless the person being prayed for has an objection. If after sufficient explanation they remain hesitant, avoid using the oil.
- **Since several groups may be praying at the same time in the same room**, every **attempt should be made to control loudness of speech and song to not interfere with other team’s activities**. God is not the author of confusion.

There will be **no ministering one on one alone in a room**. If an emergency arises where an intercessor is alone with a person requesting prayer, ask someone from the church office or staff personnel to stand in briefly for that time of prayer.

Intercessor's Qualifications and Training

I. Introduction

- **Weekly Hours of Operation** are:

Tuesdays—7:30 pm to 9:00 pm

Thursdays—11.00 am to 1:00 pm
1:30 pm—2:00 pm—

Post ministry Intercessory staff meeting.

- Intercessors will meet for prayer 30 minutes prior to each meeting.
- All DIRECT ministry to sick individuals will be done by teams of 3 or more intercessors.
- Any music played during prayer time will be soft background music, preferable instrumental to avoid distracting from spoken prayers.
- **Special Instructional Materials** will be available for people who come for prayer. Be certain these are accessible and properly distributed **after** being prayed for.

II. Qualifications & Training

- **To qualify as a team intercessor**, interested individuals must:
 - have a letter from their pastor indicating they are in "good standing" within their church.
 - All intercessors must have received

the Baptism of the Holy Spirit and be leading a Spirit-filled Christian life.

-Must successfully pass a screening interview and complete the Intercessors Training, both of which are conducted by the Healing Room Ministry Overseer.

- **Intercessor Training is required and will consist of:**
 - Introduction to Healing Room Ministry
 - Word of God regarding Healing
 - Road Blocks and Barriers to Healing
 - The Healing Anointing
 - Authority of the Word & Baptism of Holy Spirit
- **Required reading for Intercessors :**
 - Christ the Healer by F.F. Bosworth
 - Bible Healing Study Course by Kenneth H. Hagin.
 - God's Creative Power for Healing by Charles Capps.
 - Healing the Sick by T.L. Osborn (optional but highly recommended).
- Any or all of the above **training requirements may be adjusted or waived** by the Healing Ministry Overseer.
- **Registration and Praise Reports** forms are used to help gather statistics and keep records. Intercessors will ensure they are properly filled out by the person requesting prayer.
- A log of Healing Room staff and individuals requesting prayer will be maintained.
- Scheduled Intercessors who can not attend on their designated day, are asked to contact the

Healing Room Overseer prior to the scheduled day, if possible.

- **Intercessor's Appearance & Conduct** -
 - Avoid wearing heavy amounts of perfume, cologne, scented hair spray or after shave because sick individuals may be highly sensitive to them.
 - Breath mints are ALWAYS a good idea.

III. Prayer\Healing Room Guidelines

- **Team Prayer** will emphasize unity of the spirit. One person will be designated the leader and will lead the prayer time with other team members adding only as led by the Spirit. Leaders will rotate throughout the daily session.
- There will be no "praying on top of" the lead prayers being offered and no loud, distracting comments of agreement. Prayers being offered are intended to be heard by the person being prayed for. All team members are to listen to the prayer being offered and agree and build on them only as led by the Spirit.
